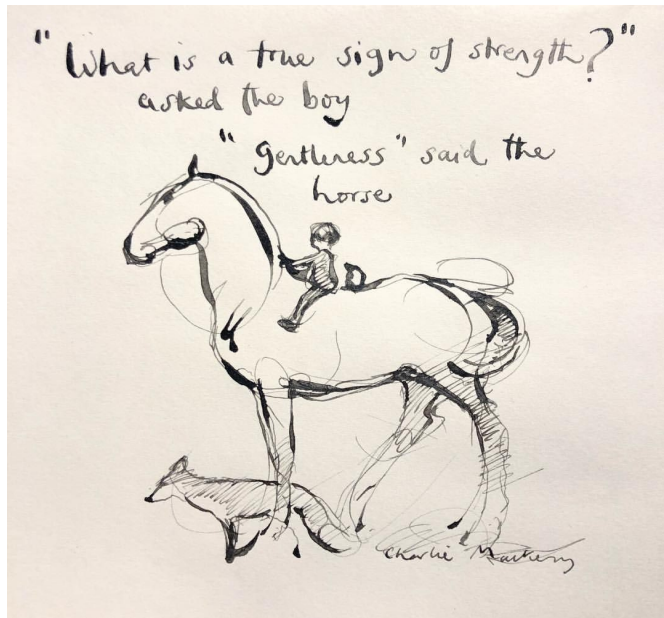

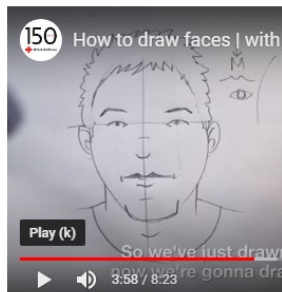


Sharing experiences of empathy and resilience

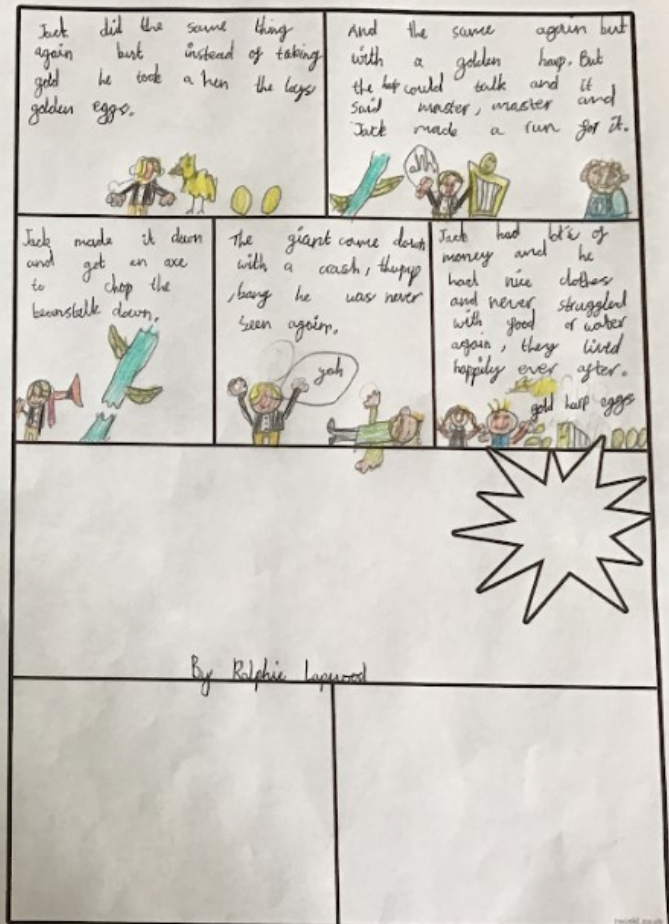


About Rhodes

It takes approx. 3hrs 45min to get to Rhodes Town from England by aeroplane.

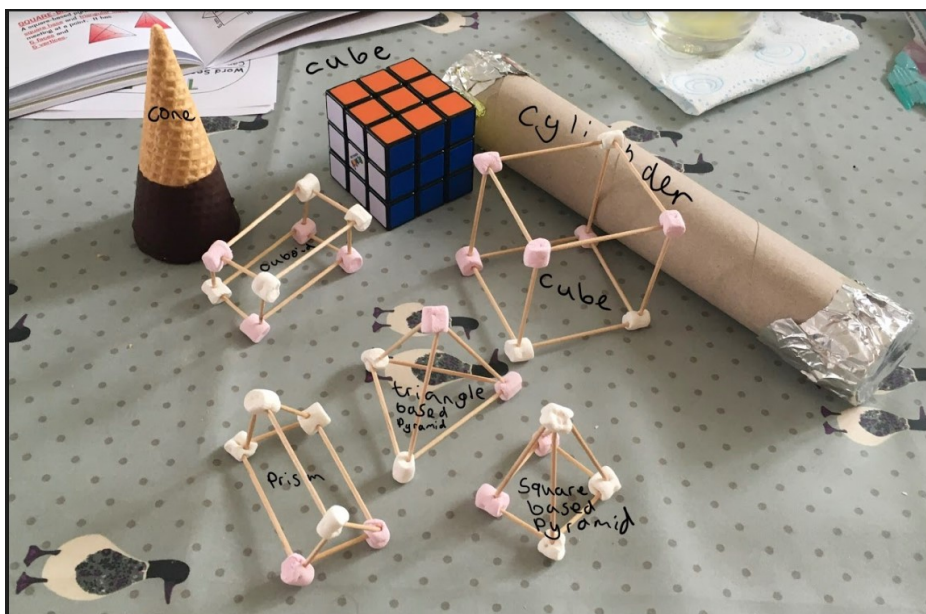
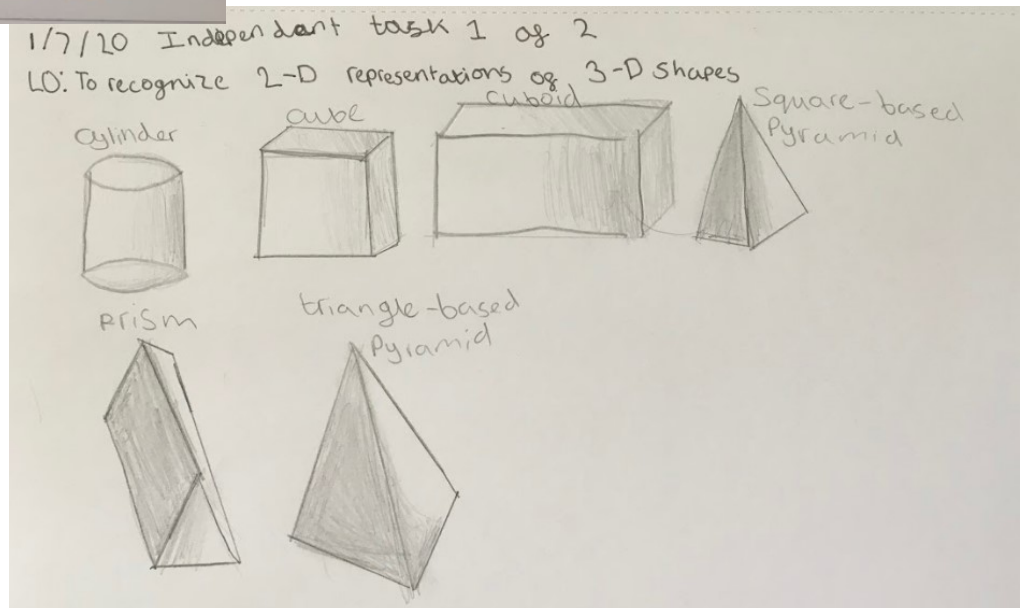
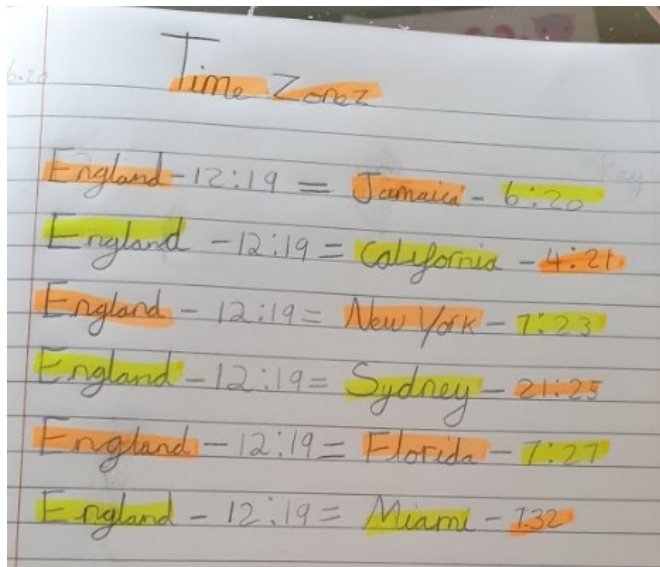
