Starting next week, pizza will replace the existing hot option each Thursday.



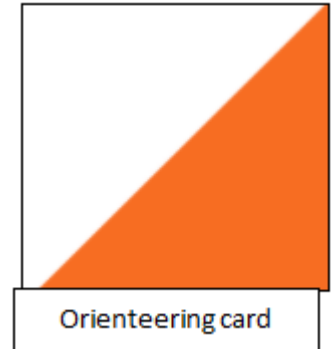

We were really lucky to have a zoom meeting from The British Museum this week!

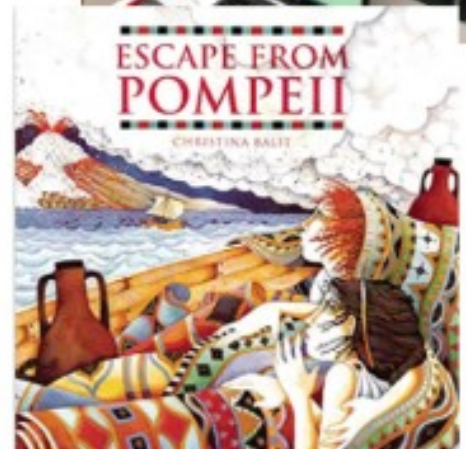
