These are the children who have been spotted shining in school this week. We could have chosen so many children- the decisions were hard to make!

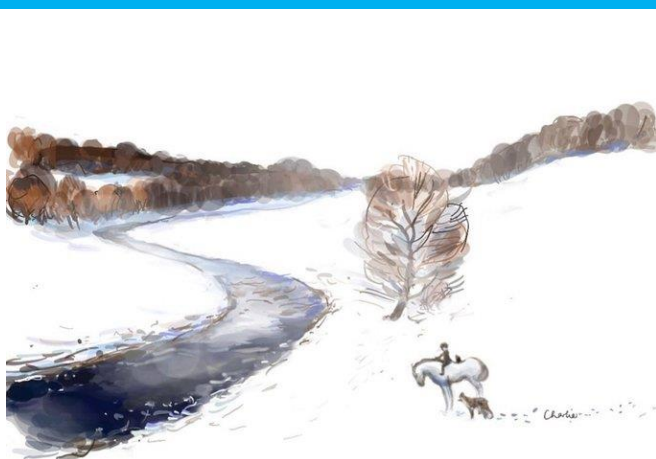
