


Wishing a very Happy Birthday to those who have celebrated their birthdays between:

# Year 4 and Mrs Waring's Micro-bit computing lessons.












Thank you to Mrs Waring for coming in on a day off to give the Year Four children an additional computing lesson using Micro-bits.

They all really enjoyed the lesson and now Mrs Spilling and Miss Watson are skilled up in teaching micro-bits too!








These are the children who have been spotted shining in school this week. We could have chosen so many children- the decisions were hard to make!
