Advance notice: Temporary closure of Hoe Mill Bridge, The Causeway, Ulting

We are writing to provide you advance notice that ground investigations are due to take place at Hoe Mill Bridge along with sign replacement works from **Monday 13 September** until Friday 24 September 2021.

Bridge Closure

Due to the restricted working area when carrying out ground investigations, it will be necessary to temporarily close Hoe Mill Bridge on The Causeway, 24 hours a day, seven days a week for the full duration of the works (13 September to 24 September 2021).

Signed diversions will be in place during the planned road closure as no vehicles will be permitted to pass over the structure during this time. A diversion is proposed via The Causeway, Crouchmans Farm Road, Ulting Road, The Green, Maldon Road, Hatfield Road, Langford Road, Langford Road Roundabout, Heybridge Approach, Pond Roundabout, Maldon Bypass, Spital Road Roundabout, Spital Road, Wycke Hill, Wycke Hill Business Park, Limebrook Roundabout, Limebrook Way, Oak Corner, Southend Road, Chelmsford Road, London Road, Old London Road, Herbage Park Road, Church Hill, The Street, Rectory Road, Hoe Mill Road and vice versa.

During the bridge closure, Hoe Mill Lock will remain accessible to vehicles via The Causeway, Crouchmans Farm Road.

Local temporary traffic signals

Furthermore, signage replacement works will be conducted during this period with the support of temporary traffic signals between the hours of 9.30am and 3pm at the various locations between Danbury, Hoe Mill Bridge and up to Maldon Road (Hatfield Peverel).

Provisions will be made to allow pedestrians and dismounted cyclists to pass over the structure

This latest information including proposed diversion routes and map of proposed signage locations are reflected on our dedicated webpage which is accessible from: <u>www.essex.gov.uk/highwayschemes</u> and searching for '**Hoe Mill Bridge, Woodham Walter**'. Please note that dates may be subject to change if the works are affected by poor weather or if unexpected issues arise.
