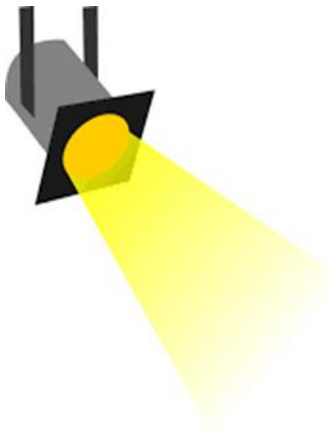


# Spotlight on Year 3



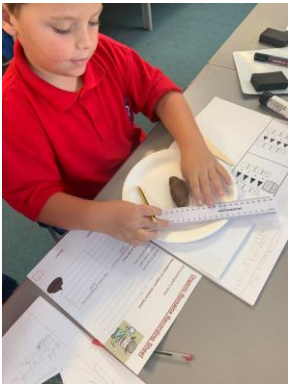
On Thursday, Year 3 enjoyed a trip to Chelmsford Museum for a day filled with Stone Age activities: they made their own paint and created some cave paintings, they became archaeologists and examined Stone Age artefacts. They tried their hand at drilling holes in flint, grinding grain for flour and weaving and found out about changes over the very long period in history that was the Stone Age. The museum staff were very impressed with the knowledge that our Year 3s already had about the Stone Age. The children's behaviour was exemplary behaviour throughout the day and the Year 3 staff were very proud of them indeed.





# Spotlight on Year 3

The children had to dissect two different poots to identify whether they came from a Neolithic or modern day diet. The children learnt about British plants, seeds and berries that grow in the wild, as well as the origin of some of our modern day foods.
