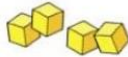

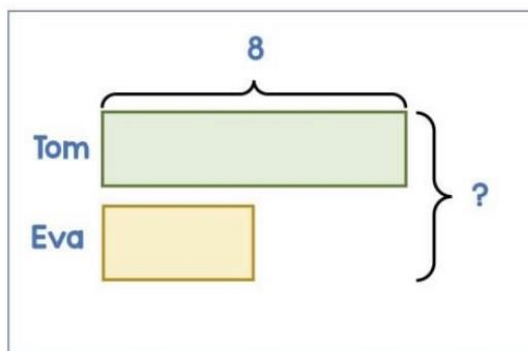


1 Tom has 8 cubes.

2 Jack puts the same number of coins in his money box each day.

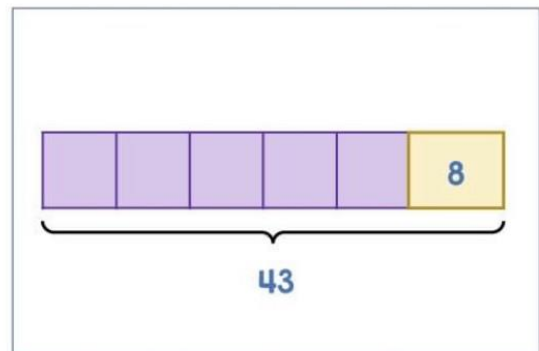
He does this for 5 days.

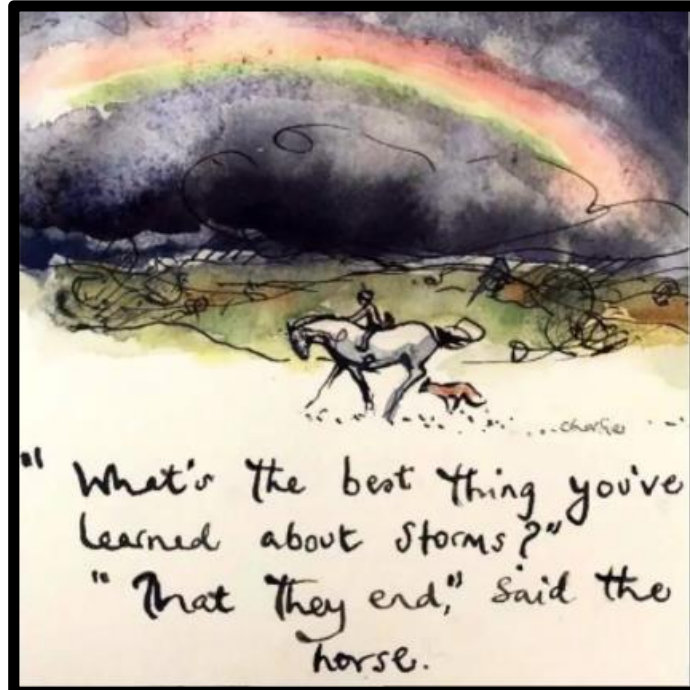
