notice to help parents with work commitments.

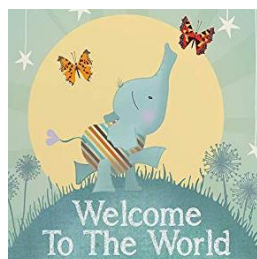
Thank you for your support with the JSA's Smartie Challenge,
