Spring term parent consultation appointments

- I am very pleased to be able to invite you into school for a parent consultation appointment this term. Should there be a rise in positive COVID-19 cases (within the school community) these may be changed to phone calls if this is deemed safest. I would ask all parents to wear a mask on site (unless medically exempt) and to carry out an LFT before arrival.
- On Tuesday 8th February and Thursday 10th February, between 3.30pm and 6.30pm we will be holding consultation appointments for years 3, 4 and 6. Year 5 will have their parent consultation appointments on Tuesday 8th and Wednesday 9th February between 3:30pm and 6:30pm.
- We are planning to hold face-to -face appointments this term; these will be held in classrooms to allow greater social distancing and to ensure you and our staff are as safe as possible.
- We are allowing one appointment per child, so we ask that you liaise between yourselves if you and your child's other parent do not live together. In some situations we will provide an equivalent length phone call on another day- but requests for this are to be made to Mrs Black via email - admin@hatfieldpevereljun.essex.sch.uk
- The arrangements are as follows:
- Please arrive via the main school reception, where you will be signed in and directed to your child's base.
- You will have an opportunity to look through their books which will be on display in one of the year group bases.
- The consultations will take place in the opposite base where appointments will be 8 minutes long.
- If it is clear a longer appointment is needed, the class teacher will invite you to continue the discussion at another time.
- Please allow time to get to any siblings appointments when booking.
- If your child is on the SEND register, One Plan updates will be shared as part of your meeting. An updated copy of your child's One Plan will be emailed out to you by the admin team towards the end of the Spring term, once Spring term assessments have been completed.

- The appointment slots will be closed at 3pm on Monday 7^{th} February so please book early.




These are the children who have been spotted shining in school this week. We could have chosen so many children- the decisions were hard to make!

Spotlight on History in Year 3

Year 3 had their Ancient Egyptian Day on Tuesday. Everyone got into the spirit of things and we were very impressed with the effort that the children (and parents) had clearly put into their costumes. The children looked amazing.

There were home-made sandals, headdresses, and all sorts!

We started our day with a description of the mummification process, which we then used to help us in mummifying a banana. This involved making an incision in the left side, scooping out the contents and preserving the skin with natron (a mixture of sodium bicarbonate and salt). We were very impressed with the children's sewing skills to close the bananas.













Spotlight on History in Year 3

Next, we learned all about the diet of Ancient Egyptians, tasting different foods such as dates, figs and olives. Some children have developed a taste for olives now!

In the afternoon, we learned about canopic jars and designed our own version using a pringle tube! The children created an armature (scaffold) using newspaper and tape, which they will cover with Modroc (bandages with plaster of Paris).
