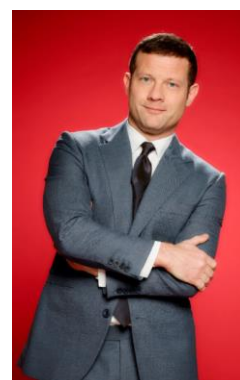

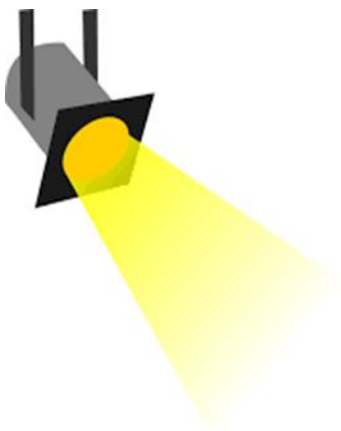


Story in a Jar Competition results:
