Latest Guidance for Parents from the ECC Director of Education: Covid-19

The Legal Duty to Self-Isolate: As of Thursday 24 February 2022, the Government has removed the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test. Adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days or until the 10th day.
