Free Young People's Orchestral Workshop Sunday 22nd May 2022 at St John Payne School, Chelmsford

Following a year's break due to the pandemic, the Essex Symphony Orchestra is delighted, once again, to be able to invite young musicians to join them for a morning or afternoon to experience orchestral playing alongside experienced players and under the guidance of our professional conductor, Mr Robert Hodge.

The workshop is for pupils who learn an orchestral instrument in or out of school and who have passed at least Grade 1. There will be two sessions held on Sunday 22nd May:

10 – 12.30 for those who have passed Grades 1, 2 or 3 1.30pm – 4pm for those who have passed Grades 4 or 5

To comply with safeguarding guidelines, a parent or responsible adult will need to accompany their child to the workshop; in previous workshops parents sat all around the edges of the hall and really enjoyed watching how the music came together.

<u>The Queens Platinum Jubilee interactive Safari Beacon Trail, 30th – 12th June & Colouring</u> <u>Competition</u>

Three exciting family trails have been launched across Braintree District this week to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

Braintree District Council has partnered with High Street Safari to bring these fun, engaging trails to Braintree, Witham and Halstead town centres to help primary-aged children learn about the Jubilee in a fun and interactive way.

Families can visit the High Street Safari website to locate the first story points in each of the trails and then head out to start their mission.

At the first location children need to hunt for a Jubilee-themed character which will usually be displayed in the window of the premises. There will be a QR to scan which reveals the first instalment of the story and allows children to see them in augmented reality.

From there participants are led to six other destinations around the town, with each one offering a new character to collect and the next part of the story.

The free trails are live now and run until 12th June, giving families plenty of time to take part. Once the trail has been completed users will discover details of any beacon lighting events happening in the area so they can continue their Jubilee celebrations.
