On Wednesday 28th September, Year 5 went to London to visit the Greenwich Royal Observatory. The children have written about what they got up to...

The best thing about the Royal Observatory is the planetarium. When you enter the planetarium, you will see hundreds of seats. When you get in those seats, you will lean back and the show will begin!

We got to choose which planets we wanted to see. They came spinning closer from the solar system. Our class chose Saturn and Mars. Saturn has lots of rings and it's biggest moon is called Titan.

In the show, you get to learn about two planets that your class votes for. We picked Mars and Saturn. We learnt that Mars is very small because when the planets were made, Jupiter captured more rocks and metals from the atmosphere and stole them from Mars!

All entries must be able to be reproduced using standard four colour process (no cotton or glitter please) and must be no larger than A4. Entries must not be folded, and the artist's name, age and school should be clearly marked on the reverse of each entry. We will need all this information to be able to return the artwork to the schools after the competition.

All entries must be received in my Westminster office at House of Commons, London, SW1A 0AA by **5pm 11 November 2022**. The winner and runners up will be announced in the following two weeks, and I will then contact the winning pupil's school to arrange for a prize to be presented to them. Unfortunately entrants submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

I appreciate how busy the school schedule for this term will be but hope that your pupils are able to participate in what should be an exciting and creative Christmas competition this year. Pupils are also welcomed to enter individually from home should this be difficult for schools to accommodate but they are reminded to ensure all relevant information to be included at the back of their entry.

I very much look forward to receiving all these excellent entries.
