## Braintree District Council £150 rebate available for households

The Discretionary Council Tax Rebate is a one-off payment of £150 to eligible households in council tax bands E-H to help with rising energy costs, part of the government's Energy Bills Rebate scheme announced earlier this year.

The scheme will close when all the available funding has been distributed or on the 30 November 2022, whichever comes first.

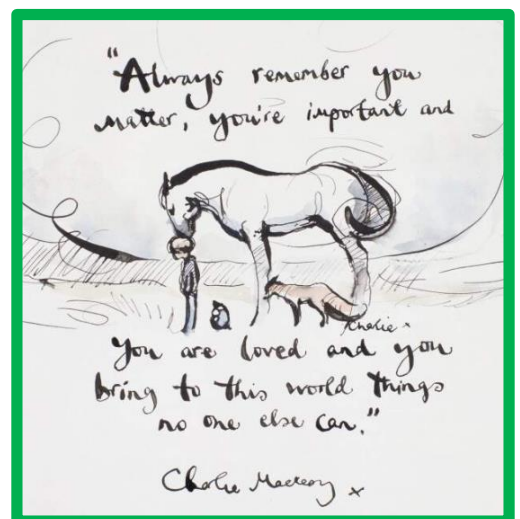

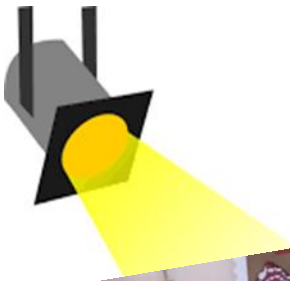

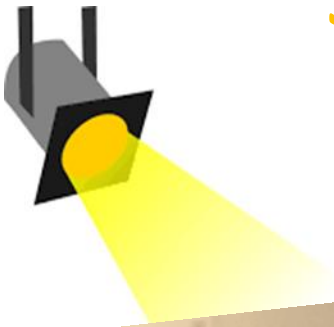


# Spotlight on the JSA disco

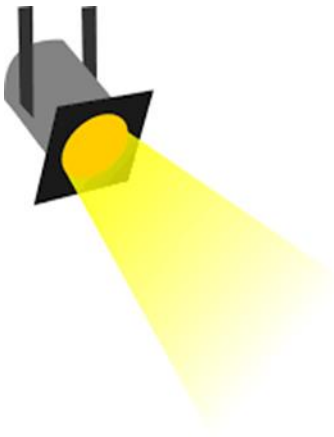

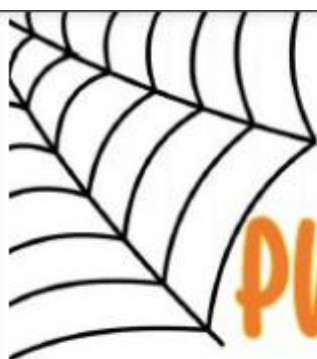
