PARENTS WITH YEAR 2 CHILDREN

As you are aware, parents of current Year 2 children at an infant school need to make a formal application to the Council for a Year 3 place and can do so via the website www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

The junior admission round opened on **7 November 2022**, for parents of children in Year 2 at an infant school to apply for a junior school (Year 3) place for September 2023.

The statutory national closing date for applications is **15 January 2023**.



Fire burn, and cauldron bubble.*






Minaya participated in two events in the Chelmsford Competitive Festival of Music which was held last Saturday (5th of November), and obtained the following achievements:
