**URGENT NOTICE:- SUNSHINE CLUBS, AFTER SCHOOL FOOTBALL CLUBS AND SCHOOL MEALS DEBTS**

At this difficult financial time, as we're sure you are aware, all schools are finding it increasingly difficult to manage the budget provided. The Governing Body have a responsibility to ensure that the funds available are used to provide the best possible educational experience for **all** children attending the school. The Governing Body have therefore asked that all outstanding debts for school meals, after school football clubs and Sunshine Clubs are cleared without delay. Going forward, any debts that remain outstanding may result in further action being taken:-

1. Parents to be contacted to provide packed lunches when school meals have been ordered but a debt remains.
2. Children unable to continue to attend after school football club.
3. Children unable to continue in Sunshine Clubs.
4. From January 2023 we will be introducing late payment charges for our Sunshine Clubs. If payment is not received by the due date a late payment charge of £5 will be added to your account and this will increase by £5 every 7 days until payment is received. These charges will then be added to your next invoice.

We're sure you understand the very difficult position we are in and will help support the school by settling any remaining debts. This will save us both the embarrassment of having to take next steps - thank you.

If you would like to speak confidentially with Mrs Black regarding any outstanding debts, then please contact the office.


The Drama Club has proven to be very successful and the children are absolutely loving it! There are more spaces available from January, so please do let us know if you child would like to join and we will reserve them a space.



P5 - Solo Piano ages 7 and 8 - 2A distinction certificate with a score of 85%



The Standards and Testing Agency will update schools and stakeholders as to what this means for key stage 2 test week as soon as possible this month.



