#### School Council Eco Christmas

This week's eco Christmas tips come from Lola-Rose and Ben (Apple), Leo (Birch) and Jaidyn (Rowan) and focus on Christmas crackers:

- Buy Christmas crackers that don't have plastic toys inside and are fully recyclable
- Consider donating some money to a tree planting charity to offset your carbon footprint.
- Have a go at making your own Christmas crackers!

Cut a piece of thick
paper or thin card to
approximately 16cm x
25cm



In our last meeting of the term, we had a go at making our own Christmas crackers using a very simple method. Why not try yourself? Cracker snaps are available from HobbyCraft or Amazon.

Fold it in half lengthwise. Repeat so it is in 4

long quarters.



Selotape a snap inside secure with tape at each
end. Add a hat, joke and 6
chocolate or small treat.
Pinch the ends together
and tie with string or
ribbon.



Fold each end in by about 5cm.



Open it out and adjust the folds so they are all mountain folds (point outwards)



Snip off the 4
corners of the
folds you have
just created.
