Spotlight on Geography Day


Geography Day!

We had a wonderful day in school on Thursday 2nd February, exploring all things Geography! The children were very excited and loved learning about different cultures and where our clothing comes from.

We started the day with the children's favourite Geography song! Click the link <u>here</u> to listen to it and I'm sure your children will sing along!


Every class collected data using our clothes to find out which countries they were made in. Most children predicted China but we actually found countries like Bangladesh and Pakistan were a lot more common! Year 3 made a tally chart, Year 4 a pictogram whilst Year 5 and 6 made bar

graphs.





In the afternoon, each year group explored a part of the world linked to their year group topics and produced some art work. Year 3 focused on the United Kingdom and created cityscapes comparing Chelmsford with Hatfield Peverel. Year 4 created some amazing drawings of the Leaning Tower of Pisa and The Colosseum in Rome linked to their topic of Italy. Year 5 looked into the Haida tribe located on the coast of Canada and recreated drawings of animals that would be traditionally carved on totem poles. Finally, Year 6 studied an artist from Brazil called Beatriz Milhazes and created their own versions of her abstract paintings using collage.

Her family are extremely proud of her and so are we! Well done and many congratulations Minaya.






