ParentPay - our new online payment service

Our <u>current</u> online payment provider (Pay360 Education Payments) has presented a number of difficulties to several families with some still unable to register and take advantage of online payment with us. We are therefore pleased to announce that from 1st April we will be accepting payments online with an alternative provider - <u>ParentPay</u> - for items such as dinner money, school trips and clubs. Using this secure <u>website</u> you will be able to pay online using your credit / debit card. <u>ParentPay</u> will be our preferred method of making payments to school - from 31st March you will no longer be able to use <u>Pay360 Education Payments</u> to make online payments to our school.

What are the benefits to parents & pupils?

- ParentPay is easy-to-use and will offer you the freedom to make online payments whenever and wherever you like, 24/7
- The technology used is of the highest internet security available ensuring that your money will reach school safely - offering you peace of mind
- · Payments can be made by credit/debit card

 - NB. These are for one-time use only, please choose your own username and password for future access during the activation process
- Provide all the necessary information and choose your new username and password for your account - registering your email address will enable us to send you receipts and reminders
- Once activation is complete you can go straight to Items for payment, select which item(s) you want to add to your basket and proceed to complete your payment
