Dear Parents and Carers.

I would like to thank you all for your patience and flexibility during this unsettled time of strike action. This has been very challenging to navigate as a leader. I urge you to remember that the staff who have chosen/been able to strike have been doing so with the express rationale of highlighting the need for improved funding for all children in schools. The national press focuses on pay (as a trade union dispute this must be the primary reason) but the fact of the matter is in years gone by any pay rise would have a grant to schools to cover in the increase in salaries. This is no longer available, so any pay-rises are coming directly from the 'pot of money' dedicated to the children.

On the strike days the teaching assistants, Mrs Dutaut and Mr Pheifer began a number of significant remodelling and organisation of school spaces. These will create better learning environments for all children!

On Tuesday we will also be having remedial work on our drains, which are very old and are causing many headaches (understatement!), I am trying to make sure that there is a physical positive impact in school during this time!

We are already excited to host next year's competition for our local Primary Schools.


