Hot school meals cannot be ordered in class on the day. Home packed lunches will need to be provided for children who haven't pre-ordered.







Little havens helped Ellis whilst he was suffering with neuroblastoma cancer.


They have also been there for Rhys since Ellis passed away with their care and support and Rhys would like to give something back.


