Hot school meals cannot be ordered in class on the day. Home packed lunches will need to be provided for children who haven't pre-ordered.



Wowzer! What a fantastic morning we had at our 2024 Poetry Slam!



The Slam finished with a thumping rap – all about World Book Day – complete with actions and attitude galore!






Spotlight on Year 5 Easter performance 'Roll back the Stone'
