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

## Spotlight in Year 5

Our science topic in Year 5 this half term is lifecycles. As a result, the school bought caterpillars and chicken eggs for the children to observe.

Over the past two weeks, we have been watching our caterpillars get larger and larger. When they attach themselves to the lid of the cup, they are ready for the next stage of their lifecycle which is a chrysalis. Some of these caterpillars look like they are ready to do this. Hopefully, after the bank holiday weekend, they will emerge to become butterflies!



The chicken eggs arrived on Monday and by Wednesday lunchtime our first one hatched! It was so exciting to watch. Most of the children chose not to go out on their lunch break that day as they wanted to watch the moment the chick emerged from the egg. Once it had arrived, we all went off to lunch and by the time we came back, there was a second chick! Mrs Black named the first chick May and we put lots of name suggestions into a name generator and Fluffy was chosen as the name for the second chick.

Lots of children (and adults) were glued to the screen on Wednesday night as we hoped more chicks would hatch. By morning, we had two more! The children have named them Oakley and Maple.

The chicks are adorable and the children love being able to watch them grow and develop. They certainly make a lot of noise as we can hear them whilst we are doing our learning!

Please note that ties for third place will all qualify, but tiebreak rules will be used to determine trophies and medals. All players scoring a minimum of 3.5 points will qualify for the Gigafinal.

The top 3 U7s, U9s and U11s will also qualify automatically (boy and girl) - assuming they haven't done so already using the criteria above.
