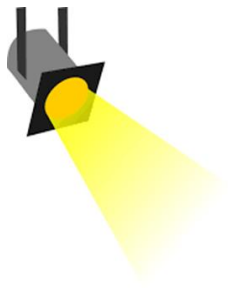

It was a fantastic sports day. Thank you once again for your continued support.



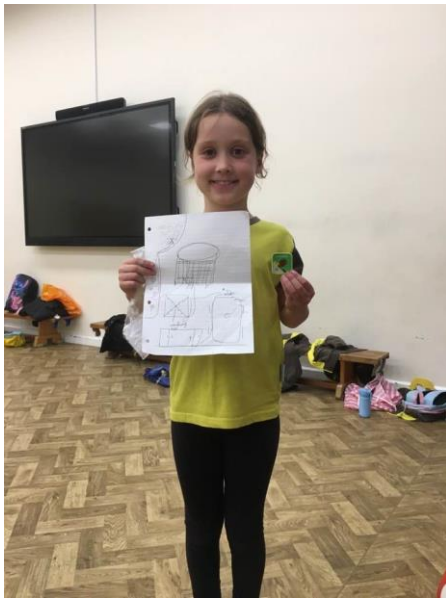
