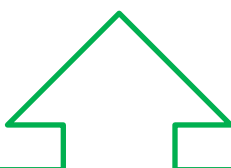

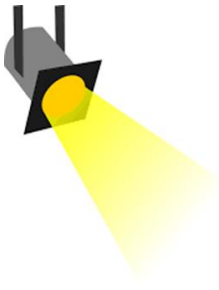

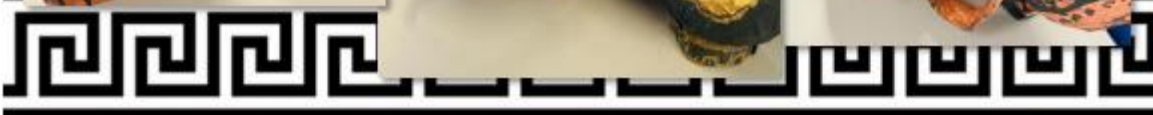


# Spotlight on Art in Year Six
