

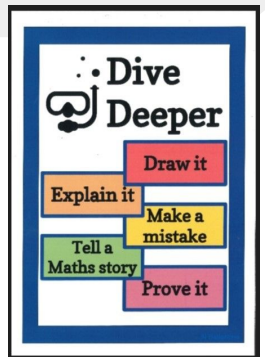
MATHS



I am so excited to kick off our first Curriculum Corner this year by sharing with you a little about how Maths works at St. Andrew's! We take a 'Mastery' approach to teaching maths, where the children are taught through whole-class interactive teaching with the focus being on all pupils working together on the same lesson content at the same time. This ensures that all can master concepts before moving to the next part of the curriculum sequence, allowing no pupil to be left behind, which fits in with our school belief that every child should have the opportunity to shine.

Our mastery curriculum is developed through research and resources by the National Centre for Excellence in Teaching Maths (NCETM) and teachers adapt learning to meet the needs of the whole year group. All children have the opportunity to access extensions and deeper thinking. One way we do this is through our 'Dive Deeper' poster.

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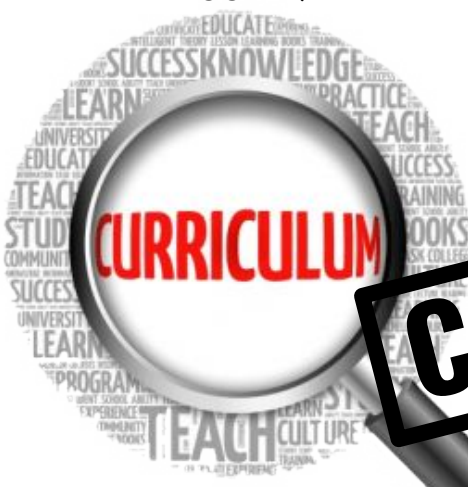
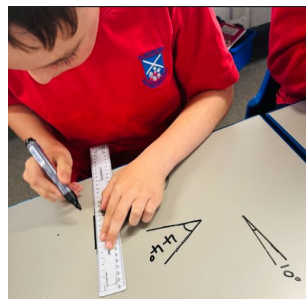


Competition Time
