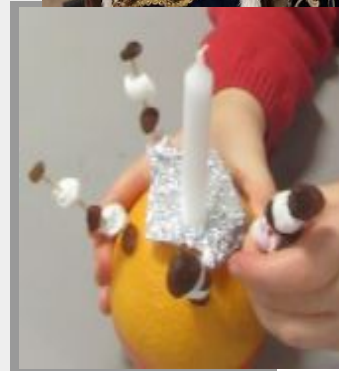


# RE
