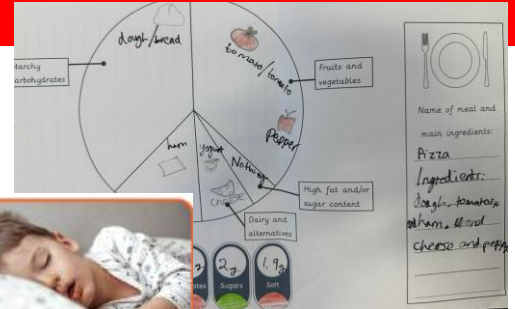

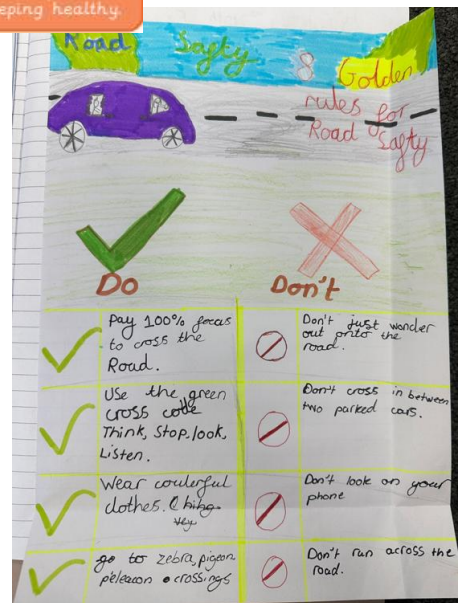
HEALTH & WELLBEING

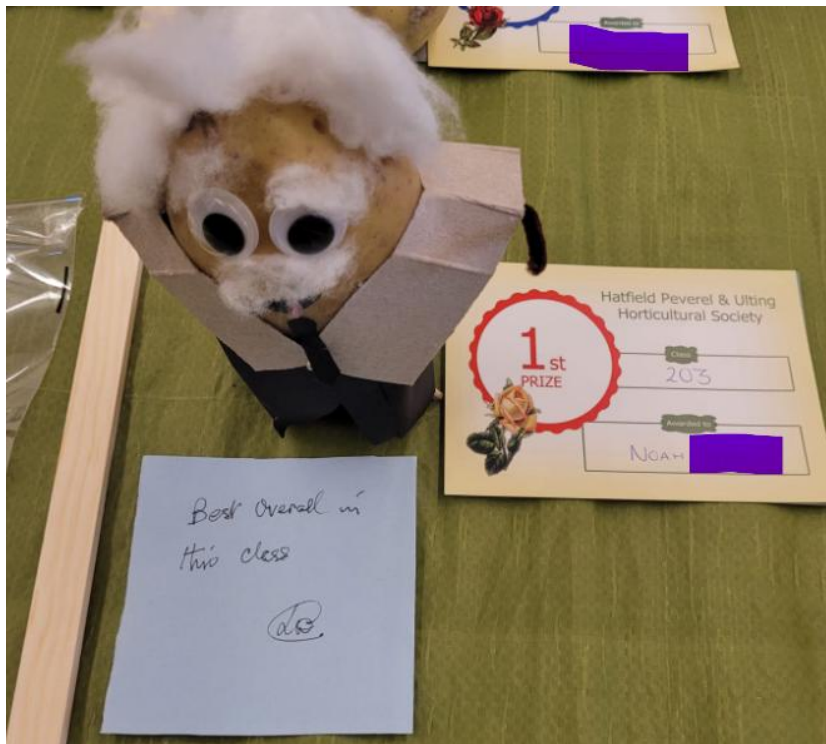

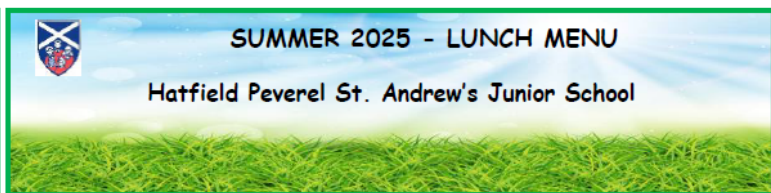
