The PE and Sport Premium

Overview

The PE and sport premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. The government has spent over £450 million on this funding over the 3 academic years. Each school receives a lump sum plus a premium per pupil per academic year. The allocation for our school for 2016/17 was £9,515.

How was the money spent/allocated?

About 50% of the allocation was spent on providing curriculum instruction and coaching for all pupils in high 5 (netball) and dance. About 30% was used to release teachers (providing supply cover) to attend local sporting events with children, to organise the school's own events and for PE CPD. About 20% is allocated to purchasing resources and equipment. A further 10% has been used as our affiliation fee to the Witham and District School Sports Association. This association organises a variety of inter-school sports competitions throughout the year, including football, high 5, cricket, rugby, rounders, athletics, swimming and cross country.

What effect does it have?

All children received a weekly 1 hour session of physical activity in either high 5 or dance which is in addition to regular curriculum P.E. sessions such as gym and games. School teams have had a number of successful results in recent years;
